



NEW PUPPY UPDATE FOR 2012 AS WELL AS NEWS ABOUT THE HAWAII HUMANE SOCIETY

We have fostered more than 75 dogs and cats over the past two years. We are proud to be helping the Hawaii Humane Society. We take care of all the animals' needs from food to pooper scooper duty. Being a homeschooled family, we can take care of animals as young as six days old.



The small, six day old puppies are the hardest to take care of because they need to be fed every two hours, that includes midnight, and they need to be kept warm 24/7. Either way, we take care of them.

RV FINDS NEW HOBBIES

We found some new people who were into a lot of arts and crafts. The peoples' names were Kathleen and Scott. They made tables, trivets and blankets. The family did the tables and trivets first:

TABLES AND TRIVETS

The first step is to cut out the design of wood (which is usually round or square) and cut it to the desired size. You would then take some colored stones and make the desired pattern. This may take several days. Once the pattern is set. You would glue the stones onto the wood one by one. The table will have to set for a day to let the glue dry.

The trivets are done almost the exact same way. The wood would be cut into shapes such as an octagon or hexagon. Both shapes are very popular.

PRAYER BLANKETS

The prayer blankets are fun but very repetitive. You would find two layers of material. A front, or the side displayed, and the back, the side which will be on you. You would lay the two pieces on top of each other. Then next step is to cut strips of about two inches long and about one inch wide in both layers. These cuts should be on all four sides of the material. Once that is done, you tie each one to the one from the other.

The tabs must be tied to the one from the other material or the two pieces won't be joined together. You should make a prayer with each knot, this makes it a prayer blanket.
